Jyotirmoy Private ITI commenced its academic journey in 2018 with two vocational trades—Fitter and Electrician. Each trade comprises three units, with a total annual student strength of 120.

Both theoretical and practical classes are conducted with a clear objective: to develop students into skilled workmen equipped with industry-relevant competencies. Upon successful completion of training, students are placed as freshers across sectors such as automobile, heavy electrical and mechanical industries, with starting salaries ranging from ₹12,000 to ₹15,000 per month.

After gaining around one year of experience, many progress to positions under the Engineering Chamber of Commerce scale. Several students are now employed outside the state, particularly in Pune, Gujarat and Maharashtra, earning basic salaries of up to ₹34,000 per month.

Beyond academics and technical training, the institute emphasises overall development by organising annual tournaments, picnics and industrial tours, offering exposure, recreation and valuable industry insights.
